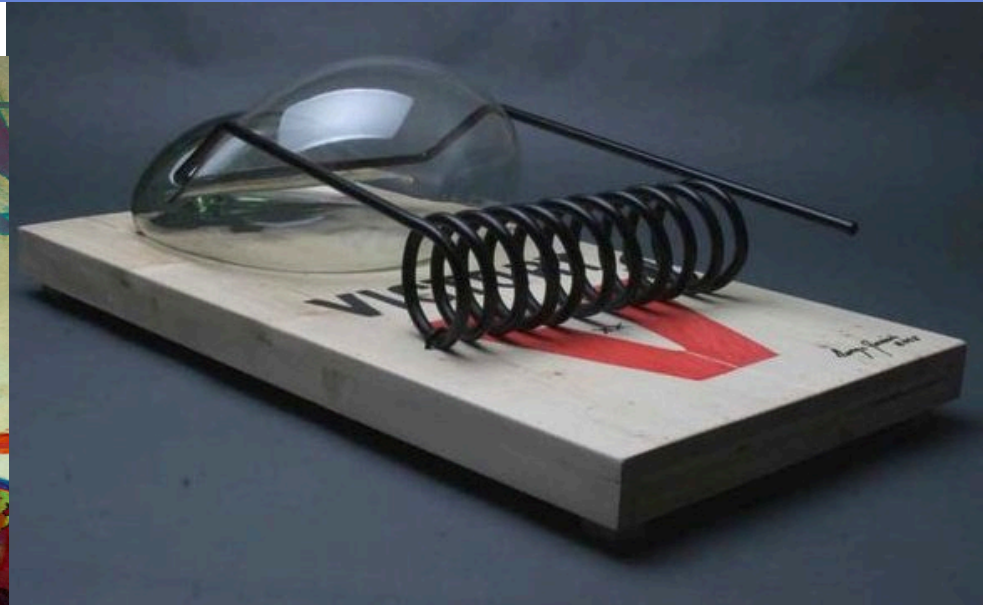
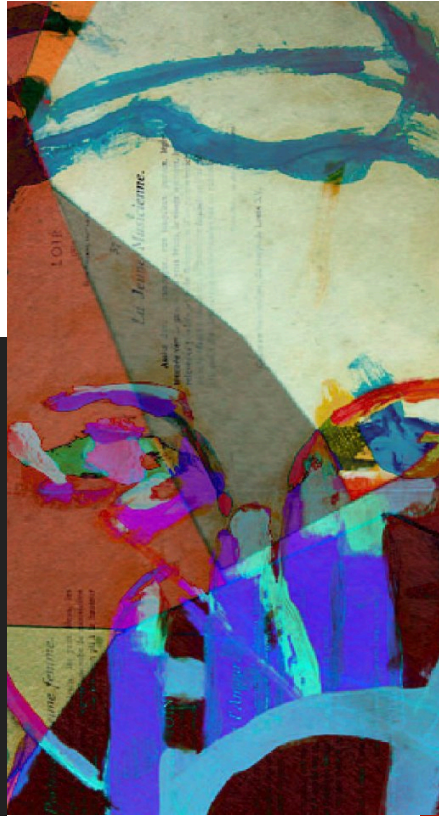


Call for Entries: The Phantom Project

What is a Phantom show?

Phantom shows are pop-up art shows in ephemeral galleries. The location is set for Phantom shows based on available vacant urban retail space. Phantom show locations will vary based on available vacancies and the good will of property owners. Location: 672 Higuera St, San Luis Obispo between Tom's Toys & West End Coffee

Run of show: Feb 2 to March 2, 2012

Intake: Saturday, January 28, 8 - 11:30 am

Pickup unselected work: January 28, 1 - 3 pm

Note: This is the same day as intake.

Show opens: February 2 in time for Farmers Market, 4 - 9 pm

Opening reception: Meet the artists at Art After Dark, February 3, 6 - 9 pm

Closing reception: Art After Dark, March 2, 6 - 9 pm

Pick-up unsold artwork: Saturday, March 3, 11 am - 3 pm. (The phantom project will not be responsible for anything left after March 3.)

Friday through Sunday 1 - 5 pm

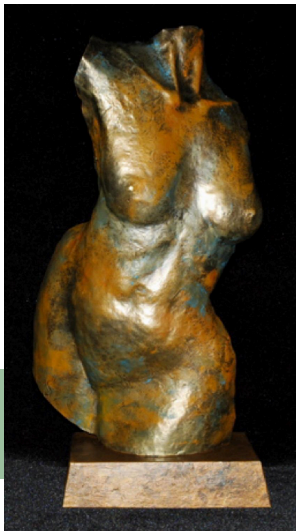

Scope of entries: Work will be considered in all 2 and 3 dimensional media. (No installation, video or projection)

Jurors: Glen Starkey, New Times columnist and artist

Entree fee: \$25 for up to 3 pieces

Awards & commissions: Cash prizes, to be announced / 20% commission
Artists whose work is accepted must sign up to sit in the gallery for one 4-hour period during the run of the show. You can optionally pay \$10/hour in lieu of sitting at the show.

Installation and removal of fragile or heavy pieces is the responsibility of the submitting artist. We advise that you arrive early with such items on the intake day. (Metered parking begins at 9 am.)

No early submissions. Complete forms, pay fees and deliver work on intake day.
